

MAHONE BAY TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES – AUGUST 11th, 1919

The adjourned meeting of the Town Council convened in the Town Office.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Ernst at 7:45 pm.

Present: Mayor, Councillor's Begin, Fancy, McLean, Smith.

Councillor McLean reported he and the Mayor had gone to Lunenburg to-day not being able to locate the Sheriff, interviewed Mr. Matheson. Tendered him \$126.80, which he refused. He would accept amount of account and expenses less \$5.00. We then offered \$144.80, the amount he agreed with the Town Clerk to settle for, which he also refused. As the expenses nearly \$22.00 appeared to us as out of reason, we left the office. We are endeavouring to effect a settlement through Mr. Starratt.
