

MAHONE BAY TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES – MAY 13, 1919

Meeting of the Town Council convened in Penney's Hall on above date.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Ernst at 8:30 P.M.

Present: Mayor and Councillor's Begin, Cochrane, Smith, Penny, Fancy and McLean.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and after a lengthy discussion, approved.

Moved by Councillor Penney, seconded by Councillor Fancy – Councillor Smith be presiding Councillor. - Carried.

Mayor Ernst reported interviewing Mr. Holloway under existing circumstances he is unable to act as Stipendary owing to his receiving more remuneration from his municipal appointment than from this one, and further he does not care to give advice until such time as the Council starts business in the right way.

Moved by Councillor Begin, seconded by Councillor Fancy – The report be received. - Carried.

Councillor Begin reported interviewing several parties re: Offices, asking them to submit offers in writing, up to the present, no communications had been received.

Moved by Councillor Fancy, seconded by Councillor Smith – A committee on By-laws be appointed. - Carried.

Moved by Councillor Penny; seconded by Councillor McLean – The appointments to the School Board be made. - Carried.

School Commissioners – The Mayor; Councillors Begin and Fancy

Moved by Councillor Fancy, seconded by Councillor Smith – Meeting Adjourned.
