

MAHONE BAY TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES – JULY 10th, 1919

Meeting of the Town Council adjourned from Tuesday, convened in the Town Office on the above date.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Ernst at 8:10 p.m.

Present: Mayor, Councillor's Begin, McLean, Smith, Penney, Cochrane and Fancy.

Moved by Councillor (no name), seconded by Councillor Fancy, The P.P. Committee interview W.H.S. Zwicker and secure from him definite information as to when the Old School Building will be removed. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Begin, seconded by Councillor Cochrane, The Mayor interview John H Mader and ascertain from him his instructions as to repairs on the Clearland Road and Maders Cove Road. Carried.

The Light Committee to interview Jas. W. Zwicker and enter into an agreement as to services or secure some other competent man.

Moved by Councillor Cochrane, seconded by Councillor Fancy, The Clerk be bonded for \$1000.00 in the London Guarantee Co. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Fancy, seconded by Councillor Penney, The Council examine the Mill property at Mush-a-mush and at Oakland, Monday evening at 7 O'clock. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Smith, seconded by Councillor Cochrane, J.W.B. Keddy be supplied with cement for a water trough to be erected by him, under the supervision of the Street Committee. An agreement to be entered into and five dollars rental paid to Mr. Keddy. Carried.

Chairman McLean of the Road Committee reported that Engineer Forbes would come to Town Friday and Saturday and complete work desired. Moved by Councillor Penney, seconded by Councillor Fancy, The engineers services be secured and necessary survey work performed. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Fancy, seconded by Councillor McLean, The Mayor and Councillor Begin be a Committee to interview Mr. Holloway as to his appointments as stipendiary. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Fancy, seconded by Councillor Smith, The meeting adjourn. Carried.
