MAHONE BAY TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES - JULY 22th, 1919

Meeting of the Council convened in the Town Office on above date.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Ernst at 8:05 O'clock p.m.

Present – Mayor, Councillor's Begin, Fancy, Cochrane, McLean, Smith and Penney. J.A. Roberts was present on invitation of the Mayor.

Minutes of the last meeting read and approved.

Reading of Correspondence. Moved by Councillor Fancy, seconded by Councillor Cochrane same be received and each discussed. Carried.

Phone at Depot. Moved by Councillor Smith, seconded by Penney, This letter be referred to the Board of Trade. Carried.

Union of Municipalities, Mr. Roberts as Secretary of the Union asked permission to address the Council and spoke at great length on the advantages to be gained by joining the Union. Moved by Councillor Cochrane, seconded by Councillor McLean, The Town of Mahone Bay unite with the Union. Carried.

Chairman McLean of the P.P. Committee reported he interviewed Mr. Zwicker re: removal of Old School Building and he promised to commence to remove it in two weeks.

Special Council Report re: Stipendiary. Moved by Councillor McLean, seconded by Councillor Penney, The report be received for consideration. Carried.

After a very lengthy discussion it was moved by Councillor Penney, seconded by Councillor Smith, The appointment be deferred until next night of meeting.

Carried.

Moved by Councillor Fancy, seconded by Councillor Smith, The By-laws having been amended in compliance with the instructions received from the Deputy Provincial Secretary, they be adopted by this Council.

Moved by Councillor Begin, seconded by Councillor Penney, The Clerk notify Mr. E.A. Wile that a toilet must be erected on the Veinotte property at once.

Carried.

Mr. Roberts was asked many questions bearing on the legal workings of the Council and Town.

Moved by Councillor Fancy, seconded by Councillor Cochrane, Meeting adjourn. Carried.
