Moved by Councillor McLean, seconded by Councillor Penney – The Clerk write O.W. Millett, asking for his account to June 30th and statements re Battery charging machine. Also demand same.

Re Stipendiary: Moved by Councillor McLean, seconded by Councillor Cochrane – Mayor Ernst tomorrow, employ a lawyer, and take up with him the matter of the appointment of a Stipendiary Magistrate, and have the present situation cleared up.
