Moved by Councillor McLean, seconded by Councillor Smith – The delegations demands be accepted and the Clerk empowered to adjust and pay over to any section amounts due them on present assessment demanded. - Carried

E.P.Meagher representing the American La France Fire Engine Co. addressed the Council re: Fire Protection.

Special Committee re: same reported progress.

Moved by Councillor McLean, seconded by Councillor Cochrane, The question of reimbursement re: Harry Joudrey be laid over until next meeting. - Carried

The Mayor reported he had interviewed Mr. Holloway as to his accepting the position of Stipendiar and he had promised to resign his Municipal appointment in short.

Moved by Councillor McLean, seconded by Councillor Penney, The Assessment Act; Section 19 be adopted by serving each person, firm and company with a written notice as per Form in Act.
