Presentation of Police Reports

Sgt. Ferguson presented the quarterly and annual statistical reports for the Town of Mahone Bay as well as the annual statistics for the Lunenburg Detachment.

Highlighted in Sgt. Ferguson's review of the reports were smooth posting season which saw full staffing complements leading to a greater number of officers available to do proactive patrolling, the work of the Community Policing officer in re-establishing the Victim's Services volunteers, and patrols on local trails. Sgt. Ferguson also reviewed special enforcement plans that have been put in place to address areas of Town where the speed signs are tracking high rates of speed. Scarecrow festival coverage and the way that a community member can call in a complaint to the RCMP, as well as what to expect in the way of follow-up were also discussed.

New Business

Website Content Review Survey

Committee members received a survey requesting their opinions, in consideration of the mandate of the Police Advisory Board, regarding content on the website. Committee members were asked to submit their responses to Ms. Hughes on or before November 15, 2019.

Plan Review Priorities Survey

Committee members were asked to offer their opinion, in consideration of the mandate of the Police Advisory Board, regarding priorities for the Plan Review. Submissions were requested on or before November 15, 2019.
