#### 2.1 Staff Report – Edgewater Street Living Shoreline Project (Phase 2)

Council received a report with a proposal for a next phase of the Edgewater Street Living Shoreline Project.

A motion by Deputy Mayor Kangata, seconded by Councilor Wilson, "THAT Council approve the signing of a letter indicating the Town's support for the Coastal Action-led application to the federal Natural Infrastructure Fund (NIF) for a next phase of shoreline improvement on Edgewater Street and indicating the Town's commitment to

contribute \$100,000, should the project receive NIF funding approval.”

### 2.2 Staff Report – Regional South Shore Sustainability Summit

Council received a report intended to present council with a proposal for a Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) Regional Climate Program in Lunenburg County.

A motion by Councilor Feeney, seconded by Councilor Nowe, “THAT Council approve the signing of the Letter of Commitment with the AIM Network for participation in the proposed FCM Regional Climate Program and organization of a South Shore Sustainability Summit in 2023.”
