

RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Mahone Bay, Nova Scotia, that the following By-law is hereby enacted and adopted as a By-law of the Town of Mahone Bay and that the Clerk forward it to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and request his approval.

ANTI-LITTER BY-LAW

1. Any person who litters by throwing material of any kind on any sidewalk, street, road, lane, highway, parking lot, park, cemetery or burial ground, or into any ditch, brook, river or harbour, or into or against any building or on any premises;

shall for each offence be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$100.00, and in default of payment, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 10 days.
