| 1.1 | This by-law shall be known as and may be cited as the "Town Seal By-law", | Short Title |
| 2.1 | The Common Seal of the Town, made of metal, and having engraved on it "The Town of Mahone Bay, Incorporated March 31, 1919", shall continue to be the Town Seal. | Town Seal |
| 3.1 | The Town Clerk shall have the custody of the Seal. | Custody |
| 4.1 | The Seal shall be used when authorized by any statute or by any by-law of the Town or by direction or resolution of Council. | Use |
| 5.1 | All deeds or documents to which the Town is a party and to which a seal is requisite, shall be authenticated by the Town Seal and the Mayor and Town Clerk shall when | Documents |



duly authorized sign such deeds or documents and affix the Seal thereto.

6.1.1 The Mayor or Town Clerk may affix the Seal to any proper certificate or document for the purpose of the authentication of the same upon payment of such fee as fixed by subsection 6.1.2 hereof.

Authenti-
cation

6.1.2. Persons requiring the Seal to authenticate documents shall pay to the Town a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each such authentication.

6.1.3. Notwithstanding subsection 6.1.2. no fee shall be charged for authentications on Certificates of Appointment of Town Officers required by or in any court of law.

7.1 The following form may be used when any document is to be authenticated by affixing the Seal thereto:

8.1 All former Town Seal By-laws of the Town are hereby repealed and this by-law substituted therefor.
